Comments	<p>The A283 and A24 already see a significant amount of HVG traffic and the local villages of Storrington and Washington are already rat-runs due to the poor local transport infrastructure. Recent publicity naming Storrington as one of the most polluted areas of the UK shows that the area really cannot cope with the impact of additional HGV traffic. This will also impact on commuters using the roads and needless to say will make the roads an even more dangerous place for the more vulnerable road users such as cyclists, pedestrians and horse riders.</p> <p>The proposed site is on a major aquifer and any waste used to fill in the site risks significantly affecting the quality of water supplies to a vast number of the population of the South East of England.</p> <p>Local residents WERE NOT CONSULTED in advance of the cut of period for objecting to the application.</p> <p>Peregrines nest in the quarry. Another nationally scarce bird, the sand martin, nests in the quarry. The impact on our valuable and fragile environment will be devastating.</p> <p>The site is in full view and earshot of one of the South Easts iconic landmarks - Chanctonbury Ring. The instigation of a landfill process will ruin the experience for the many thousands of people who come to enjoy the South Downs National Park each year.</p> <p>I strongly object to both the application and the process by which this application was undertaken.</p>
