Comments	<p>REF: Additional Information Reg25 Dated 06/12/2022</p> <p>Application number: WSCC/028/21 Site: Rock Common Quarry, The Hollow, Washington, Pulborough, RH20 3DA Proposal: The continued winning, working and processing of sand from the existing Rock Common Quarry, the importation of inert classified engineering and restoration material, the stockpiling and treating of the imported material, the placement of the imported material within the quarry void and the restoration and landscaping of the quarry</p> <p>Your comments:</p> <p>My objections to this planning proposal are based purely on the detrimental effect this will impact towards the health and safety of the local people and residents. Secondly, the road infrastructures both locally and nationally that will need to be burdened with thousands of additional HGV vehicular traffic movements to and from the Rock Common quarry immediately impacting the A24 and A283 and beyond. The extreme poor levels of air quality that are an everyday experience to residents and local people in Washington, Storrington villages and surrounding areas, due to the levels of Nitrogen Dioxide, PM10 and PM2.5 particulates from vehicular movements at this present time, the cause and effects this will have on future air quality due to the increase in HGV movements. The impact on wildlife in general, now the original plans (that go back some years), if not the case, will see an incredible detrimental effect on the opportunity to put 'something back' for the good of nature and wildlife will be sad.</p>
