Comments	<p>OBJECTION</p> <p>I am dismayed and outraged that Wiston Estate have one again put in an application to dump waste material into Rock Common Quarry. This is clearly not restoration it is LANDFILL. I remember very well the last landfill application that Wiston Estate made approx 15 years ago that blighted my childhood, and the many years of concern, anguish and campaigning it took my parents and the local community to successfully fight that. My home is just a few metres from the boundary of this quarry and right next to the digger/dumper truck entrance. It is very noisy and dusty already, especially in the garden where I like to sit on my days off. They have not mentioned any of the extra dumpers etc that will have to use this entrance/exit on a daily basis, or taken into account any of the noise, dust, pollution or vibrations that these vehicles will make. Why? I also cannot believe the amount of traffic that will use The Hollow road junction onto the A283. I use this road/junction everyday to travel to and from work. 500 huge lorry movements here everyday I will almost certainly be squashed, run off the narrow road or worse! This junction is already dangerous with the lack of hedge/grass cutting obscuring vision on a dangerous bend and in the winter with mud/debris etc it would be lethal. I am a keen photographer and often photograph the wildlife in and around this quarry, to think that all wildlife would be lost for decades is unbelievable. There are many rare birds that live here, the Peregrine Falcons that breed here every year, the Sand Martins, Kingfishers etc. There are lizards, protected Newts, Dormice, Badgers, Bats the list goes on. How can the WSCC possibly allow their total destruction? Please leave the quarry to the wildlife! WSCC MUST OBJECT TO THIS APPLICATION, IT IS OF NO INTEREST TO ANYONE BUT WISTON ESTATE AND DUDMAN, BUT IT WILL AFFECT THE LIVES OF MANY FOR DECADES.</p>
