Comments	<p>I wish to object to this application as I consider it will be detrimental to the local environment over the next decade. The infill of 2.7 cubic metres of inert waste over 8-10 years will create 600 single lorry movements daily from The Hollow, along the A383 to the Washington roundabout and then onto the A24. This will create noise, dirt and congestion and must be seen in the context of the new WSCC Minerals Plan which already approved a new sand quarry at Ham Farm on the A283 near Steyning and an extension to the Chantry Lane quarry near Storrington. These will also be creating many additional lorry movements, with the associated noise, dirt and congestion over the same ten year period, and traffic usage along the A283 will also be impacted by the 600 homes and warehousing currently being built in Lancing and the large development at Toad Hall in Hove. Levels of usage of the A283 have already increased dramatically in recent years and this is a rural single carriage rural road with high accident levels already.</p> <p>I do not think that the existing approval to create a lake in the quarry will be dangerous- yes there will be deep water but the site can be fenced with warning notices. The applicants say that creating a landscaped bowl will be out of keeping with the local landscape but that is insignificant in comparison with the negative impact of importing 2.7 cubic million metres of waste along the A283.</p>
