Comments	<p>We strongly object to the proposed development which would be highly detrimental to both local residents, the wider community and local environment.</p> <p>The additional lorry traffic generated would be entirely unacceptable on a number of grounds; the A283 is already highly congested and local air quality around the area is already poor due to traffic pollution, additionally the junction providing site access is currently dangerous to vehicular and cycle traffic. Hundreds of additional lorry movements will in our opinion undoubtedly have high and unacceptable potential for accidents/fatalities on the road.</p> <p>The noise and air pollution generated, along with dust generation will be highly detrimental to the quality of life of local residents, particularly those bordering/ in close proximity to the site. The impact on the neighbouring campsite and businesses dependant on local tourism should also be duly considered.</p> <p>The site is borders a national park and AONB, the proposal will have a negative impact on the enjoyment and preservation of the park. As stated by numerous local residents, the site provides a unique habitat for numerous species,including rare birds, protected newts and lizards etc etc and should instead be preserved as such. Use for landfill/"inert materials" would destroy a valuable environment at a time when environmental protection and preservation should be a top priority. The risk of irreversibly contaminating waterways/ the aquifer below the quarry should also be considered.</p> <p>Similar proposals have been rejected on numerous occasions, having presumably been non-compliant with local and county environmental and waste policies and clearly being unacceptably detrimental to local residents, the SDNP and environment. We strongly urge that this proposal is likewise rejected. Only Dudman and Wiston Estate will benefit from this proposal at the expense of many others.</p>
