Comments	<p>In response to your letter dated 13 December 2022 I have the following comments to put forward. I confirm the details of my earlier response to the initial planning application and emphasise the inconvenience and devastation that would be caused to customers of the Washington Caravan and Camping Park which occupies the adjacent area on the western boundary of the Quarry.</p> <p>In respect of the further information supplied by the Applicants I have the following comments to put forward.</p> <p>I note that the additional information has been supplied in response to questions raised by the West Sussex County Council, the South Downs National Park Authority and the Environment Agency. A flood risk assessment should have been available with the original Planning Application,. I am very concerned that any attempt to change the existing system of water discharge from the Quarry. This would cause a real possibility of serious flooding to the lower areas of the Camping and Caravan Park from the increased water level flow from the Honeybridge Stream.</p> <p>The proposal to extend working hours to include Saturdays is completely unacceptable. Any such proposal would seriously affect the well-being of visitors to the popular Caravan and Camping Park, other visitors to Washington and the residents of the Village who would deserve some respite from the noise and dust pollution and increased vehicle movements occurring from the previous 5 weekdays . I urge the West Sussex County Council to dismiss the original Planning Application and the further information.</p> <p>My wife and I are regular users of the Washington Caravan and Camping Park and at the end of it's working life for sand extraction would wish to see the Quarry returned in a minimalistic way back to a natural feature.</p> <p>Robert W Cummings.</p>
