the previous landfill is now failing
and toxic waste is being allowed to
enter into Honeybridge stream
poisoning the surrounding woodland
and wildlife. If the proposals are
allowed to proceed this will only get
worse.

Furthermore, any work carried out will
involve hundreds more lorries daily using
the surrounding roads creating noise,
pollution and dust which will further
impact on the environment.
Ironically, to carry out even a small
extension on a private property, there has to
be details included in the application
stating which materials and finishes are
used and how it impacts on the surrounding
areas. These plans can be turned down if they
don't meet the council's approval. In comparison,
these proposals should not even be
considered. Please do **NOT** let this go ahead!
