Wiston Estates & Dudman's have once again submitted an application for landfill and a processing / recycling plant, which will go on forever. This will have a massive detrimental affect on the quality of life, not only to Washington residents but the wider area.

500 plus lorry movements per day, will increase noise, dust and general pollution, for the next 50 years plus and clog roads for miles around. The Storrington Road is already one of the most polluted roads in the UK.
