This application has been dealt with in accordance with the Development Control Scheme protocol for small scale proposals.

This application seeks the continued siting and use of a temporary classroom for an additional two years. The use was previously permitted under application WSCC/005/19/WB and has been operating safely for a number of years. The proposals do not represent an increase in students or staff. Therefore, no concerns would be raised to its continued use from a highway safety point of view.

In summary, the LHA does not consider that this proposal would have an unacceptable impact on highway safety or result in 'severe' cumulative impacts on the operation of the highway network, therefore is not contrary to the National Planning Policy Framework (paragraph 115), and that there are no transport grounds to resist the proposal.
