Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above numbered planning application. This proposal has been considered by means of a desktop study, using the information and plans submitted with this application, in conjunction with other available WSSC map information. In respect to the above planning application I would provide the following comments.

Having consulted the online documents I can confirm that the above named public footpath runs outside the red line boundary along the northern edge of the proposed site, therefore we raise no objection to this. Having said that it is important to note that not at any stage can the public footpath be blocked, restricted or lawful users deterred as part of any proposals or future work. If there is a need to disturb the surface, restrict the width or temporarily close the path for the benefit of protecting public safety then contact must be made with WSSC's PRoW team prior to any works taking place.
