Hi James, to confirm, the Hopoast recycling centre would not be a suitable location for the transfer of such waste. The temporary measure using the HDC yard is also not suitable and that leaves Crawley as the nearest transfer station. The Crawley site also suits as the nearest site to the Redhill landfill (the final disposal destination). We will continue to explore other options within the HDC area, but these are not likely to be available in the short term.

Paul,

Please do redirect me if you are not the correct person in WSCC Waste Management regarding the following query.

With regard to the current Biffa application seeking to allow the transfer of dog waste at the Crawley TS ([WSCC/015/24](#)), you will see in response to one of my planning queries Biffa have deferred to WSCC Waste Management around options considered for the bulking of Horsham dog waste prior to onward transfer.

I would be grateful if you could briefly explain why Crawley TS is considered a sustainable location for bulking of the dog waste? Would I be correct that there are currently no other suitable waste management facilities in the Horsham area (noting that Hop Oast Depot is not strictly a waste management facility) and that the nearest alternative transfer stations would be East Grinstead or Burgess Hill? That being the case, would it be true that Crawley is the nearest TS available to Horsham for this waste which ultimately is disposed of at Redhill Landfill?
