In response to the latest information for planning application WSCC/004/20 we still object on the following grounds.

West Hoathly road is unsuitably narrow for many large vehicles having two pinch points between the rock that make up the sides of the road, there are steep gradients and the road is twisty. It is also on a bus route. There is a public bridleway crossing this road just south of the entrance to Standen. The lorries will access West Hoathly Road via Saint Hill Green, the left turn here is a blind junction and particularly narrow with any vehicle coming south unable to see traffic until nearly on the junction, lorries and buses take up nearly the whole road here. These all are very real risks and we feel pose an inevitable danger to drivers, walkers, cyclists and horse riders in an AONB and do not seem to have been addressed by this latest application.

We are very unhappy about the level of noise disturbance for all in the area, not just the traffic to and from the site but the machinery on site, many will find this distressing and negative to health. We are also concerned about the fumes from the lorries and plant machinery adding to pollution in the area affecting humans, wildlife and plants.
