Objection

I object to the proposed plan due to the following [] Air quality at the junction of London Road and Imberhorne Lane. The MSDC 2020 Air Quality Annual Status Report, shows the NO2 levels on London Road, East Grinstead are in exceedance of 44.1ug/m3. Although this monitoring site (MSAQ29) is a little further up the road from the Imberhorne Lane junction, one would come to the assumption that these levels would be equal if not higher at the London Road/Imberhorne Lane junction. With the proposed amount, frequency and period of time of this proposed HGV movement, this would have a significant increase and detrimental effect to health in an area already exceeding NO2 limits. [] The HGV's would be passing directly along the entrance to a large school which significantly increases the risk of hazards and dangers to the children travelling to and from school/crossing the road in an already very busy and congested road at peak times. [] Narrow points along Imberhorne Lane, especially the bridge over the Worth Way and Bluebell Railway and the 2 tight bends inbetween. As a local resident, who frequently uses Imberhorne Lane, I am only too aware of the problems passing large vehicles at these points. Allowing HGV's along Imberhorne Lane will only add to this and increase the potential risk of accidents. If the owner of the land is seriously concerned about the environmental hazards and impact of the land and something must be done, maybe the owner should consider the more modern approach of landfill mining and reclamation of the waste products that were disposed of there, rather than burying it - out of sight, out of mind.
