Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above numbered planning application. This proposal has been considered by means of a desktop study, using the information and plans submitted with this application, in conjunction with other available WSCC map information. In respect to the above planning application I would provide the following comments.

From a PROW perspective there appears to be no direct impact on the adjoining public footpath 2955 that runs outside the western boundary of the site. Because of this we would not object to the proposals but there are some things to consider set out below.

The existing line of the public footpath referenced must not be changed or restricted in any way by the proposals. If as part of these proposals there are any plans to gain access along the public footpath by vehicles then there must be a private right to do so otherwise this would be considered a criminal offence. Also if any damage is done to the surface due to any form of legal private right then reinstatement must take place to a standard agreed with WSCCs PROW team.

At no stage can the path be blocked as part of these proposals. If works are required on or adjacent to the path that may pose a risk to lawful path users then we would require the applicant to apply for a temporary path closure through the PROW team at WSCC. There is a cost involved and if the applicant decides not to apply for one of these and an accident occurs to any lawful users due to works on or adjacent to the path then the applicant could be liable for any injury or damages.
