## 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 West Sussex County Council (WSCC) Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA) has been consulted on the above proposed development in respect of drainage & flood risk.
- 1.2 The LLFA has previously commented both on this application (Reference F) and on a similar application that was withdrawn (Reference A).
- 1.3 In view of the changes to levels for the proposed cap system, the LLFA seeks reassurance that the flood modelling remains fit for purpose given the changes to the design.

## 2 LLFA POSITION

- 2.1 In Reference F the LLFA's position was:
