Hi Tyra,

The lorries/crane will access the site via the A27, which immediately accessing the Holmbush roundabout. They will access the site well away from any residential properties. You can see from the site plan provided, when the application was presented, that the Holmbush centre is immediately adjacent to the main A27 (the busiest road in the county). Access is provided from this road, straight onto the site, with any need to go anywhere near any residential properties (see the nearest residential properties to the right of the extract plan).


The Tesco's superstore and petrol station on this site is 24 hour opening, so the site gets other traffic throughout the day and night!!

The submitted plans give the location of lorries and the crane, again extracted for ease, see below

These works involve lifting a single modular unit over the school boundary, therefore the lorry and crane will be in position for an hour at most.

If WSCC require residential consultation, beyond the usual notifications, then please advise?

There will be little or no noise caused to the residents during the delivery and off load of the building, as the nearest residential property is 132m meters away as the grow flies. The on site works will be completed during normal working hours and are restricted to service connections and provision of an access path. Access for these works will be via the main school entrance driveway, with only small machinery able to gain access to this location.
