Comments	As a resident of Climping would like to place on record my objection to this planning application. The plant is a very large monstrosity and is far to big for a rural setting, the sheer size of the plant will make it easily visible from the Southdowns national Park, which is a discouragement for potential visitors to the area as well as an eyesore for the local residents. The site positioning is outrageous, particularly when there are approximately 3,000 new homes to be built in close proximity(Ford, Yapton and Climping). Such a plant would spoil the whole setting of these three communities. The project will create a huge increase in HGV traffic movement which will be using Church Lane and the A259, both of which are already struggling to cope with existing traffic numbers. At peak times there roads are already gridlocked with the existing traffic flows. Church Lane is in need of major upgrade and is in its current state would not be able to sustain the anticipated increase in traffic numbers, especially HGVs. The increased HGV traffic will also create safety issues fir the residents wanting to cross Church Lane to get to the local school, walking to the Beach or into Littlehampton. This is due to the lack of any pavement on the West side of Church Lane. The recent planning applications for Climping, this small rural setting, would appear to be being transformed into a major industrial development site and this is unacceptable. The project construction is planned over 5 years so it will coincide with the anticipated house building in Ford and Climping making the amount of traffic. Finally as a similar plant has recently been approved in Horsham then surely this begs the question is this plant really necessary? I would sincerely hope that the council will understand and accept the concerns of the local community and reject this application
