When we moved to Yapton in 1995 it was an attractive village with fields, containing deer and a wide variety of wild life with a limited amount of traffic. Even then, they had started building more houses and were having problems with the required increase in drainage. Objections to further applications for building were raised, and those applications consequently declined temporarily. However, gradually, applications for further housing were resubmitted by housing development companies those objections seemingly ignored and by degrees a steady number of applications were accepted with no consideration for the existing residents, so that now in every direction you look, there are houses under construction, signs heralding further building or plans for more sites. West Sussex seems hell-bent on destroying every stretch of green and every vestige of rurality that ever existed with more and more and more houses. It couldn't be a more residential area. Now in a residential area that is already struggling with an increased traffic load and demand on infrastructure, you want to put a massive waste management plant with all the attendant air pollution, noise, impact on the already suffering wildlife and environment and 120 lorries thundering through on a daily basis in a residential area? In light of the above, with special concern for the increased danger for children on the roads and pollution for a rising number of inhabitants, I could not object more strongly.
