Comments	I have just heard about this scheme which seems to have been kept as quiet as possible and put out for consultation at a time when people are distracted by the current Covid19 crisis. That seems to me to be artful at the very least. The proposal summary is totally unsatisfactory as it fails to mention the huge chimney stack the developers require.
