Comments	We do not need more incinerators or to generate more landfill. We need more recycling. Instead of building incinerators the money should go into making recycling better and for councils to meet their recycling targets. Climping is a semi-rural spot between the South Downs and the coast. The Grundon transport plan outlined is for hundreds of lorries to come through Climping every day, Grundon are directing the lorries to drive down Church Road which is an unclassified road through the heart of Climping village and past listed buildings, and onto the already overcrowded A259. People come to Climping to go to the unspoilt beach, the Climping Gap is one of the few unbuilit up areas on the south coast, to stay or have a meal or spa treatment at Bailiffscourt Hotel and Spa. All this would be destroyed by 400 lorries a day coming through Climping. The application is too close to residential housing. There are noxious substances released from these chimneys. It will generate noise, dirt, pollution, smell and litter. This is a low lying coastal area and the views are of the South Downs, Arundel Castle and Arundel Cathedral. This is not the place to put a monstrous building that will be seen for miles. I believe that WSCC should question the need for this incinerator. However there is no question that Ford is a totally unsuitable site for a plant of this size, scale and type of operation.
