Objection

The local roads would not be able to cope with the huge lorries. The road through Clymping village is narrow and unclassified. The surrounding roads are already overstretched, especially when the schools are open and during rush hour. Even more so, during the holiday season. The huge lorries would also spoil the tourist industry for this area, because the access would be through beautiful towns or villages e.g, Clymping, Arundle, Littlehampton, Bognor Regis, Petworth, Worthing and many others. Also the emissions of smells or other noxious substances and noise would have an impact on the residential areas in close proximity to the incinerator and tourist venues in the surrounding area. Safety in the event of a fire, plant breakdown or other catastrophic event needs serious consideration due to the residential areas in close proximity. The visual impact would be detrimental to the tourist industry in this area and to the wider area as far as the South Downs, 'Area of Natural Beauty'.
