Objection

1. Damage to the tranquility and peacefulness of a rural inhabited area. 2. Increased traffic danger to the many families with young children who now live on the area. 3. Does not consider (though the council planning officers must be utterly aware of) the incipient huge growth in housing developments in the immediate area. Again, housing which will contain many families with young and frowning children; families who expect that the rural nature of this area will benefit their young children as they grow up. 4. The nature of this installation means that it must produce toxic byproducts, many of which could have a detrimental effect on the health of both young children and the vulnerable. The impact of respiratory affecting agents has been thrown into sharp relief by the COVID-19 pandemic. Indeed it is highly likely that future incoming residents will be moving to the area in the belief that they are protecting their young vulnerable children by providing them with an environment which is safe and they do not have to worry about invisible airborne dangers to their children's health. 4. The local area is experiencing a huge increase in road traffic which will be compounded by the additional heavy vehicle usage in and around the area. The roads are already inadequate as it is, with little or no safe pathways for families to exercise their right to enjoy walking with their children. Combine the increase in road tonnage with the inadequate state of the roadways must inevitably result in hugely increased risk to life and limb for both pedestrians and cyclists. Given the government's desire to have the population become fitter and better able to defend against the likely continuing scourge of COVID-19, it must be reprehensible for the Council to effect environmental changes which have an adverse impact on the population's ability to take safe exercise.
