I am sensitive to the need for us to find we solutions to the challenge of waste management and all associated sustainability questions and ealise that no solution will be perfect. However in the case of this application it appears as though the process has been far from ideal and is now being somewhat opportunistically pushed through, on very lifferent terms to those initially put forward for consideration, and without appropriate scrutiny or onsultation. I have only just become aware of the plan to progress these proposals and believe that nany local residents are completely unaware of the extent of the proposals and their potential impact in their lives. I note from the Grundon corporate website that they claim a full public consultation was undertaken during April and May of this year, but even residents living immediately adjacent to the proposed site and many more in the surrounding areas were unaware of this public consultation and lon't understand how it could have taken place with anything like the required level of detail and crutiny when the whole country was on lockdown due to coronavirus. I note from the documentation vailable on line that those bodies that do represent residents: the local parish councils, have all raised trong objections to the proposals, how they have changed, the height of the proposed buildings and himney, the traffic/HGV impact and again how the numbers have increased without appropriate onsultation or consideration for local land and road use, the impact on the national park, the impact in the proposed new dwellings and so on. I believe these are all valid objections, most obviously caling back the project to be more in line with initial proposals, but it is simply unacceptable to seek o push through such dramatic revisions without appropriate consultation and consideration of the vider public and environmental impact.
