Comments	I wish to object in the strongest terms to the proposed 'Ford energy from waste' proposal by Grundon/Viridor (ref WSCC/036/20). There are a number of reasons why this proposal is wholly unsuitable Failure to comply with Ford Neighbourhood Plan. This plan was worked up with great care over 8 years and was approved by the Government Inspector and West Sussex County Council raised no objections to the plan. The proposed Incinerator development does not comply with the Plan and with 1500 homes, a new school and community building being built on Ford Airfield this proposed incinerator is wholly inappropriate and planning for it should be refused Failure to protect the surrounding landscape. The sheer size of the proposed, oversized, building in the application will have a major adverse impact on the surrounding area. It is notable that the proposed building wild warf any other buildings within this part of West Sussex and will be taller than Arundel Cathedral, Chichester Cathedral and the Kingmere Apartment tower block building in Littlehampton. Due to its size this proposed incinerator would dominate not only the immediate area but a much wider part of West Sussex. The Ford area retains much of its rural beauty and landscape and there are a number of listed buildings within view of the proposed development. Great care has been taken in the Ford Neighbourhood Plan to protect that landscape whilst accommodating an increased requirement for new homes. This application would destroy that landscape and severely impact other aspects such as the abundant willife that flourishes in the area. If ali to see how the proposed lucinerator development could ever be considered appropriate for the area and it would also have a major impact on the South Downs National Park by compromising the conservation of views out of the Park - the scale of the incinerator buildings will be clearly visible from the Park and in no way could be regarded as conserving the Park's views.
