

Some of the reasons you may wish to consider in your objection to Grundon and Viridor's proposed incinerator:

- Traffic impact: hundreds more huge lorries each day, some coming from well outside West Sussex
- Road access: Church Lane is wholly unsuited to this type of traffic, as it is a narrow unclassified road at the heart of Clymping village
- Proximity to existing and proposed residential housing
- Visual impact: it will be detrimental to the wider area over a considerable distance
- Emissions: unknown impact from gas, smells or other noxious substances on surrounding areas
- Safety: in the event of a plant breakdown, fire or other catastrophic event

Conclusion: this a totally unsuitable site for a plant of this size, scale and type of operation

Objections to the incinerator must be in by 9th August
