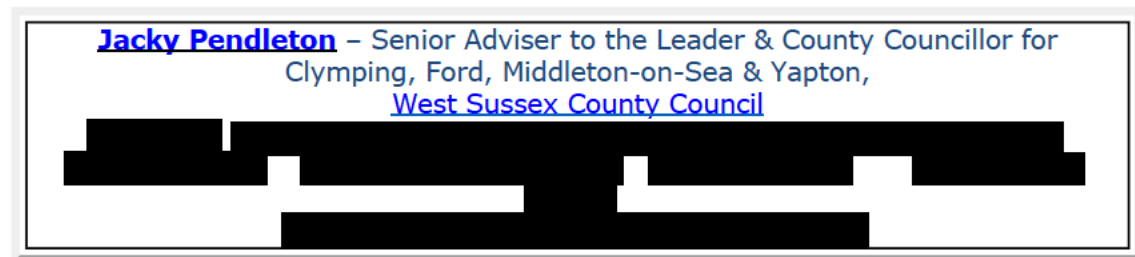

Dear Councillor Pendleton

I am writing to you regarding Viridors planned incinerator at Ford. I would like to object to this.

I live off of Horsemere Green Lane Climping and their proposal for I understand equivalent to a 16 storey block of flats incinerator with a chimney is totally unsuitable for this area. The road I live in May Close already has to put up with the stench of rotting rubbish from the recycling plant on Rudford Industrial Estate which is a constant problem. Complaints get made to the local authority it gets better then it all comes back again.

Virador moved to this area knowing full well it was semi rural with a lot of residential close by to them so if they want to extend or increase their operations they ought to find somewhere more suitable. I almost wonder if this proposal is a classic non proposal being so outrageous and out of keeping with the area they are hoping by moving from this to a smaller scheme people will be so pleased it will get consent without much objection.

I moved to Climping in 2014 and it feels like the area is under constant attack from developers, landowners etc set on ruining it.

We had the landowner who I assume owns the estate roads to Rudford Industrial Estate wanting to concrete over about 7 acres of fields for a lorry park and storage abutting Horsemere Green Lane which got seen off but he will be back in the future, the Mulgrave Estate who had owned the fields at the end of Horsemere for however many hundreds of years getting their planning for 300 homes at appeal(which I understand they have already sold on) doubling the size of the village with no proper infrastructure .The A259 which already backs up at the usual times of the day due to the Bognor bypass is going to struggle to take I presume another 600 cars going on it as will the surrounding roads.

We also are getting everyone who can trying to infill their gardens in Horsemere Green Lane and the 1500 plus homes proposed on the airfield (not sure how viable they will be if Viridor get their consent) and all the housing that has been put in to Yapton. It is like the wild west here and the latest government proposals on planning are bound to make the situation worse in Arun.

At the end of the day Climping is a small semi rural village and this incinerator plan would be the most disastrous plan yet for Climping, Ford and the surrounding area

I hope you can you use your influence to stop this proposal going ahead
