The recommendation of the WSCC Planning Officer for WSCC/045/20 at Balcombe has unfortunately added to my concerns.

I hope very much that you will vote against this tomorrow. Balcombe is an area of outstanding natural beauty and our landscape needs protecting. It would appear that this has been overlooked by the Planning Officers when making their recommendation. This is dealt with in M13 of the West Sussex Joint Minerals Local Plan.
