Comments	We live at 8 Murrell Gardens, Barnham and need to appeal this proposal on the following grounds: The area for this road is not suitable, it's far too small and not at all suitable for what is being proposed. The traffic noise, car fumes, air pollution would be devastating to all of the residents living in Murrell Gardens and Chantry Mead; there are also drainage issues which we are dependent on the fields to support the drainage for us. The proposed road would be right at the end of our gardens which would mean that we couldn't sit outside and enjoy the privacy of what we have purchased in good faith. The impact of the building of this road, would be enormous and would cause massive stress and health issues to all of us living there if this was approved even with the installation of a noise barrier, which in itself is just ugly. There are preservation orders on some of the trees. This area should be protected due to the wildlife, deer, bats, foxes, badgers, rabbits which also habitat. We have had a number of dormice in our garden recently and have a number of species of birds that are dependent on this area, ie Jays, Woodpeckers, Owls to name but a few that are becoming very rare; most of these are located in the tree line outside the Halo Site and frequent our gardens. This proposal needs to be completely re-thought out, and if it is completely necessary should be proposed more westerly past the Halo site in order to protect the conservation area with the trees located on our side, the more westerly location would also help to not impact on the already increased traffic coming through Barnham. We cannot see that this would be maintained up until now, when we are meant to be reducing our carbon footprint not increasing it. This location is part of the the natural beauty of Goodwood and Arundel and surrounding areas and as the acting Council for West Sussex, you should be proposal voiced from the monarchy during this year. This is not progress, it's destruction, and as a Council, you need to preserve and protect
