Dear Sir,

As a resident of Chantry Mead in Barnham I am dismayed at the prospect of this scheme running along the side of my property. It will destroy my view of the green space, it will pollute my lungs with petrol and diesel fumes and subject me to noise and light pollution. I have done my best to read and understand the 'non technical' details of the plan, and have read the reports written by some members of the community that do have a very good understanding of all the technical details and sadly it would appear that much of the technical information we were shown on the visual 'Fly Through' is very misleading.

It would seem that the noise mitigation barrier will be much higher than we were told, due to the new road being built on an embankment; the flood risk will be much higher, and it would seem that little regard has been paid to Good Practice, DMRB and Planning Policies. I am led to understand that SUDs standards are not being upheld, and that there is no certainty that the designed road drainage will be efficient. These are a fraction of the points raised that fall short.

I also fail to understand how a council can submit a planning application to themselves! To the lay person this cannot be seen to be transparent, and will be viewed as underhand!
