Comments relating to WSCC/052/20 - Land to the north of Eastergate and north-west of Barnham, PO22 0DF

I am writing to highlight my comments relating to the aforementioned planning application.

As Member of Parliament, I have received a large amount of correspondence from constituents who have expressed their concerns about the 3-metre metal boundary wall along the proposed realignment, specifically the excessive height and industrial appearance of the wall. I share their view that action should be taken, including reducing the speed limit on the road, to reduce the size of this wall which would be unsightly eyesore at 3-metres tall.

Additionally, it is my belief that appropriate mitigation measures should be implemented to reduce the impact on residents living in Ewen Gardens, Chantry Mead and Murrell Gardens. This should, ideally, include low-noise road surfaces, vibration reduction, protection of biodiversity and ecology, landscaping and, where suitable, compensation.

Furthermore, it is imperative that residents are subject to generous transparency in being informed where road levels on the realignment project will be raised, as this will impact those living proximate the proposed road.
