Dear James,

This memo summarises the information provided to support the discharge of Planning Condition 6 – Landscaping Scheme

Condition 6

No development shall be carried out until an updated scheme of landscaping in general accordance with the submitted Proposed Landscape Plan (Ref. A29-CAP-HPN-00-DR-C-0239 Rev P03), Landscape Planting and Seeding Layout Plant Schedules (Ref. A29-CAP-HPN-00-DR-L-0251 Rev P02) and Illustrative Section Plans (Ref. Sheets 1 to 7, A29-WSPLA-CS-001 to 007) has been submitted to and approved by the County Planning Authority. The updated landscaping scheme shall be enhanced to provide further screening to residents to the east and specify the types, size and species of all trees and shrubs to be planted; soil preparation, measures for biosecurity; details of fencing/enclosure of the planting to ensure its establishment, and phasing/timetable that demonstrate planting will be implemented at the earliest possible opportunity following commencement of the development. Thereafter the approved scheme of landscaping shall be implemented in full in accordance with the approved timetable. Any trees or shrubs which, within a period of ten years from the date of planting, die, are removed or become seriously damaged or diseased shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and species.

Introduction

The Landscaping Scheme has been updated to discharge condition 6. The following documents are required to discharge this condition.

Description of updates

Updates to the landscaping scheme from those submitted with the planning application are described below. Edits to the wildflower meadow grass mix key have been made to identify that topsoil mixing (with subsoil) is being considered in verges and topsoil inversion (topsoil buried in a deeper layer) within the larger areas to reduce nutrient levels which is necessary for wildflowers to thrive.
