Whilst I support clean waste recycling and renewable 'clean' energy, as a local resident in proximity to the planned facility I am strongly objecting to the above Planning Application on the basis of the following:

1. I believe the plan and location contravenes World Health Organisation guidelines due to the facility receiving waste and producing toxic gases and air borne particles in the close proximity to homes (many of which contain elderly, young children and vulnerable occupants with health issues) in the nearby vicinity - this detriment and risk to human health increases even more if the proposed additional 1500 homes are to be built nearby.

2. I myself have breathing difficulties and asthma, I am additionally sensitive to poor

air quality, toxic gases and airborne particles due to having had covid-19 which resulted in 2 weeks in an intensive care ward in a coma on a ventilator, almost one month recovery in hospital and then oxygen treatment and rehabilitation at home.

3. The location will have a negative impact on local wildlife, the environment and general landscape. This is a rural setting, with nearby wildlife reserves and not a suitable location for such a facility.

4. The facility will have a significantly negative impact on the local area, roads and infrastructure due to the significant increase in large lorries made worse by the volume of lorry deliveries using single track local roads. This will increase congestion, traffic delay, pollution and risk of accident.

This facility should be rejected and located far away from homes and local infrastructure and be placed on a brown industrial site with access to a dual carriageway.
