Objection

This proposal is wholly unsuitable in terms of size, scale and effect upon the already over-burdened local road network. Such a facility, if it must be built, should be somewhere with immediate access from the SRN, not which imposes an unacceptable burden on local roads and is not centrally located for maximum usefulness to the County. No junction at Ford is proposed for the A27 bypass route, meaning all HGV traffic will continue to have an unacceptable impact and pose a danger for other road users, particularly vulnerable non-motorised users. It will pose a hideous monstrosity on the landscape, affecting views both to the coast from the SDNP and from the coast to the south downs. In addition, it will belch noxious toxic fumes affecting the health of local residents and blighting the area. All the received wisdom is that these types of incinerators are outdated and new facilities should not be being built or existing facilities enlarged. In my capacity as Chair of the local Arun District Bridleways Group, I would submit that, if the County Council is minded to grant permission, then the very least that the applicants should be committed to, is mitigating their affect upon local road safety and doing something tangible towards preservation of the history of the area, by contributing both land and funds towards the project to re-purpose the old line of the Portsmouth and Arundel Canal for a multi-user greenway. This would provide some real benefit for the local community, rather than the current pathetic offering of a few signboards about the canal placed in the "visitor area."
