Comments

I would like to lodge my objection to this planning application on the following grounds. The new amended plans are similar to the original with the exception that now there will be two massive chimneys instead of one., burning 275,000 tonnes of mixed waste each year to create energy. The redesigned building is still massive, now 12 stories. The negative impact on Climping is obvious and undeniable. A minimum of 240 HGV movements will travel to and from the site each day with the only access via the A259 and Church Lane/Ford Road and every single lorry will travel through the heart of Climping. The traffic pollution and noise will be continuous for 24 hours a day, seven days a week from 6am - 8pm Monday to Friday and 8am -6pm on Saturday. The impact from gas, smells and other noxious substances is unknown and potentially very harmful to our health and well-being and to our planet. If plastic ends up in the incinerator, there is the risk of nasty toxic emissions. The fact the site will be in close proximity to a proposed new housing site in Ford and will be adjacent to the villages of Ford Yapton and Climping. The visual impact will be enormous and visible for miles, the traffic impact, as mentioned, will be overwhelming with up to 400 additional lorry movements per day. in closing the facility is not required to deal with waste produced in West Sussex, so it is unnecessary, in the wrong place and the wrong type of process for dealing with waste. This application should be rejected.
