Objection

I wish to submit my strong objection to this planning application for the following reasons. The new plans submitted are similar to the previous ones and the building is still 12 stories high and now there will be two 85 metre chimneys instead of one and they will be visible for miles. The noise, traffic and pollution will not stop, as the plant will operate 24 hours a day seven days a week with deliveries from 6am-8pm Monday to Friday, and 8am-6pm on Saturday. The impact from gas, smells and other noxious substances is unknown and potentially very harmful to our health and well-being and to our environment. If plastic ends up in the incinerator there is a risk of nasty toxic emissions. The site is in very close proximity of a proposed housing site of up to 1500 homes in Ford and adjacent to the villages of Ford, Yapton and Climping. The traffic impact will be devastating to the village of Climping with between 240 and 400 lorry movements per day, which will not only cause more pollution but create safety issues on Church Lane, which is already dangerous to walk along for pedestrians. The facility is not necessary to deal with waste produced in West Sussex, so it is unnecessary, in the wrong place and the wrong type of process for dealing with waste. I therefore strongly request this application be rejected.
