We are in the process of buying a property in Yapton and are horrified to discover the proposed incineration site which would be under a mile from our new home. Not only is this a monstrous building but the intended site is totally inappropriate for the surroundings. It is central to a residential area with schools and other public amenities close by and the effects of the incinerator would be disastrous for air quality (regardless of what PHE say), wildlife and the local road infrastructure.
