Comments	I am amazed that consideration could be given to this application as the infrastructure of this area just cannot take anymore development. I have the following objections: As mentioned above the local infrastructure cannot support any more development, this includes all the houses currently under construction. It will not provide increased employment. Building will be carried out by contractors and once completed they would employ staff from other areas with experience of working in an incinerator environment. The local roads are simply not suitable for the projected increase of heavy HGVs bringing heavy loads of waste from outside the area. The incidence of potholes has increased due to the current number of lorries from Bleach of Lavant and Grundon etc. The sub-structure of our roads is such they the volume of traffic creates potholes and these are not repaired quickly which means the pothole becomes a serious danger to life and limb of drivers, cyclists and pedestrians. Due to the number of houses being built the air quality on many of the roads has deteriorated to a level that asthma suffers are seriously at risk. This proposed incinerator would make this situation extremely bad due to the amount of CO2 it would create. Queues of traffic at peak times are adding to the air pollution and the condition of the roads. This area has many visitors and the visual impact of this incinerator is unacceptable. The view from the South Downs looking towards the sea would be marred by great blot on the landscape. Currently the views are inviting and include Arundel Castle, Arundel and Chichester Cathedrals and many areas of historic woodland and sites of scientific interest.
