Objection

The traffic impact of this development would be horrendous. Clymping village was promised improvements to the round-about at the south end of Church lane when Viridor where given permission to build their site but nothing has ever happened. We have a new development of hundreds of houses and a dementia care home already approved along the A259 plus another housing development applied for on the Ford airfield which will greatly increase the traffic along the A259 without lorries from outside West Sussex negotiating this congested piece of road to supply the incinerator each day. Based on the tonnage of waste proposed and the capacity of the HGVs used, it would require between 240 - 400 extra lorries every day of the year on this stretch of road. The car parking stated on the application assumes a 5 fold increase in these vehicles. If an accident happens near the river bridge, this area is gridlocked for hours. The facility is not required to deal with waste produced in West Sussex, so it is in the wrong location. The chimney will also be an eyesore on the landscape, visible from Worthing to Tangmere. The incineration process will produce noxious and hazardous emissions and is now considered one of the dirtiest ways of creating energy.
