I cannot believe that the incinerator proposal is still being considered when there is so much evidence that it will generate a huge amount of air pollution, is such an inefficient, dirty and expensive way of waste disposal and will be such a significant blot in the landscape in a rural area by the lower valley of the Arun. In an area with only light industry it will be hugely out of place and destroy the ambience of Ford village, Arundel and the river Arun, destroying the vistas from the South Downs to the coast. More recycling of refuse is what is required. Incineration is inefficient and filthy and will have a huge negative impact on Arun's climate change plans. All the local parishes and the district are building in sensible policies for reducing pollution, saving energy and reducing the impact of climate change, and this will ruin all of that, in fact incineration will produce more CO2 than coal and oil generated electricity.
