Comments	I have concern about noise, light and air pollution from the incinerator as it will emit fumes into the atmosphere. The visual impact effect on the South Downs National Park and the historical character of Arundel will be detrimental. No local need for incinerators, they harm recycling - The county should be recycling more rubbish and not burning it in incinerators especially given the pressures of climate change.
