	I strongly object to the proposal for the Ford Energy Recovery Facility, being fully in support of the objections from Walberton Parish Council and Clymping Parish Council. I have 3 main objections Visual Impact : The height of the chimneys put this facility at odds with West Sussex County Council Waste Local Plan (WLP), being within 400m of housing in Yapton and also visible from Walberton Parish as it will be above the horizon (3 miles away at sea level) as a major blot on our landscape. Environment: The plan is in conflict with WLP Strategic Objective 14, "To minimise carbon emissions and to adapt to, and to mitigate the potential adverse impacts of, climate change." and also conflicts with the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) paragraph 148: "The planning system should support the transition to a low carbon future shape places in ways that contribute to radical reductions in greenhouse gas emissions" Traffic : I believe that the HGV increase on Yapton Lane will be considerable, on top of existing usage both north and south of large HGVs transporting produce from local vegetable and plant nurseries, and there will be added conflict with the extra traffic from the new housing estate at Ford-1500 houses could give 3000 extra cars to conflict with these HGV movements. Also The location of the site is poor in terms of transport sustainability- as I understand it all waste movements will be by road , contrary to WLP Strategic Objective 7 "to maximise the use of rail and water transport for the movement of waste and to minimise lorry movements and the use of local roads for the movement of waste."
