Objection

I object to this enormous incinerator development at Ford. The National Planning Guidelines 148. The planning system should support the transition to a low carbon future in a changing climate, taking full account of flood risk and coastal change. It should help to: shape places in ways that contribute to radical reductions in greenhouse gas emissions, minimise vulnerability and improve resilience; encourage the reuse of existing resources, including the conversion of existing buildings; and support renewable and low carbon energy and associated infrastructure. This application fails this test. Great weight should be given to conserving and enhancing landscape and scenic beauty in National Parks, the Broads and Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty, which have the highest status of protection in relation to these issues. A building of this size and height with massive chimneys is clearly an eyesore from the Southdown National Park and Historic Arundel. It will be a massive intrusion to any view from the riverside walks alone the River Arun. Historic building and their contents could also at risk from increased emissions from the incinerator in the area of fallout from the combustion process. The application also does not comply with the Ford Neighbourhood Plan Development Policies, and poor air quality contributes to serious chronic illnesses, shortening lifespans and damaging quality of life for many people. Pollution also has major impacts both on the natural world and the state of the economy. I therefore object to the planning application.
