Dear sir I wish to strongly object to the proposed development of a rubbish incinerator at Ford for a number of reasons

The size and height of the development will have the visual impact of a 13 storey building, and the two 28 storey towers will affect the South Downs national park, schedule ancient monuments, grade 1 listed buildings and SSSI.

The development would be located in a densely populated area, and with a predominantly south westerly wind there is a strong probability that contaminants and noxious fumes would effect the population of Arundel, Littlehampton, Rustington, Angmering and as far as Ferring. Outlying villages including Lyminster and Poling would also be badly effected.

It is inevitable that the volume of traffic along the Ford Road and in the vicinity of the development would increase substantially, with an estimated 240 additional HGV movement along already traffic congested roads representing a 77% increase along the Ford Road.

Incineration is one of the worst ways of waste disposal because of its effect on climate change Incineration is a barrier to the circular economy, and in any event West Sussex already has enough incinerator sites to meet its needs.
