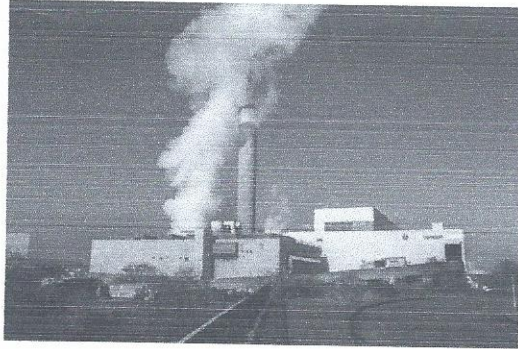


INCINERATOR
