Dear Sirs

Kindly register this objection to planning application WSCC/011/21 – Arun Valley Rubbish Incinerator.

Reasons:

Local road infrastructure cannot cope at present, let alone with additional hundreds of HGV movements.

Incinerators pollute and are detrimental to air quality – They do not generate green energy. Government/Local Government should be encouraging recycling not harming public health. The proposed development is on a ludicrously disproportionate scale to any other structure in the valley and will be a visual eye-sore.

Suggestion:

If an incinerator really is required (unlikely), WSCC should collaborate with ESCC and redevelop the brown 'field' site of the old Shoreham cement works. This has been a blot on the landscape for decades.

The demolition and partial (?) 'hiding' of the incinerator in the quarry pit would mitigate the visual impact. This section of the Adur valley has far better road infrastructure – A283, A27, A23/M23 than the Arun Valley.
