I would like to object to the revised proposal for the energy recovery facility, waste sorting and transfer facility at Ford, BN18 0XL.

1, Approval has already been given to a similar project in Horsham which is only about 30 miles away from Ford, which is supposed to be facilitating incineration of all West Sussex's rubbish.

So why does one need to be built in Ford?

2, The chimney has been reduced in height but it will still overpower the surrounding landscape, including the South Downs National Park, Arundel Town and the Arun Valley.

The chimney will be emitting particulates, dioxins, gases etc so what happens now that it's been lowered? What will happen to our air quality?


3, There are already plans in place for 1500 homes on the Ford Airfield site and building them by this energy recovery/incinerator if it is given approval is not compatible.

4, Huge increase of HGV lorries on the local roads which are not able to cope with the traffic at the moment.

5, Recycling could be much improved by WSCC rather than encouraging the approach of burning/disposal and polluting the atmosphere.

Increase of lorry traffic will also add to air pollution.
