Inpress is writing to set out our interest in the proposed new facility at Ford.

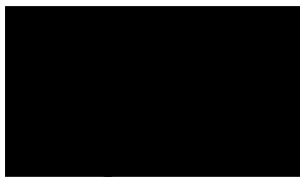
Inpress manufactures own brand and subcontract polymer products for the medical, health and industrial markets, which require technically refined moulding and assembly methods. Our factory has operated 24hrs a day throughout the pandemic. We expect significant growth over the next three years as medical supply chains refocus on UK production.

Sourcing green energy and reducing our carbon footprint is core to our vision for the future. We are part of the British Plastics Federations climate change levy opt out scheme and we met our agreed targets 3 years early. We continue to invest in energy efficiency and seeks ever more sustainable low carbon solutions.

The intended site at Ford could offer us both a source of low carbon heat and power. This local symbiotic solution would play an important part in achieving our targets.
