Subject: Proposed Viridor Incinerator at Ford

I write to express my objection to this proposal on the grounds that the proposed buildings and chimney are quite out of scale in the intended location. The flatness of the area means that these huge buildings will dominate the landscape for miles around in a largely open semi-rural area apart from the low-rise light industrial units nearby. The design proposed whilst presumably necessary is out of place in the area and is more suitable in a heavily industrialised area.

A further objection is that the traffic which would be generated would place an unacceptable additional burden on the existing road network. The three possible routes to the site are the already overburdened A259 with its dangerous junctions in the vicinity at Comet Corner and the Oystercatcher, the extremely narrow and rural Ford Lane. And the (supposedly forbidden to heavy vehicles but actually frequently used) Ford Road from Arundel.

Finally, the already approved new housing in the immediate vicinity of the proposed site means that the new houses in particular as well as many a little further away would run the risk in winds other than the prevailing Southwesterlies of objectionable and possibly noxious emissions.

For all these reasons I believe the proposal should be refused.
