Comments	<p>The planning application for this rural development is totally inappropriate for so many reasons: 1) The site is a valuable national timber resource as identified by the forestry commission and should be protected and managed as such 2) The developers activities' planned put public safety at risk by the close proximity and impact of HGVs of all types and configurations, accessing to and from the site to a number of well used public ROW which criss-crossing the proposed site and access tracks. 3) The scale and impact of this and the associated recycling building would further detract from the public's enjoyment of a tranquil woodland environment by the operation of concrete crushing, dust extraction, diesel powered generators, 360-degree excavator's and other associated equipment 6 days a week. 4) The access routes planned onto the major highways are via a restricted width (C classified) road, routed towards the villages of Bucks Green (east) and Loxwood (west) with road widths in both directions subject to numerous pinch points which are unable to accommodate more than a single passing HGV simultaneously. Numerous examples of damage to bridge railings road signs are already evident. Loxwood School drop off points on station road also add to this safety concern, as does the popularity of cyclists frequently using this narrow road. 5) Where is the local need? The applicant states that they will look to establish a local Brick manufacturing site close to the proposed quarry. Current local brick manufactures have made it clear in promotional material that they have ample stocks of clay to continue making bricks into the foreseeable future, therefore are unlikely to require any other suppliers. Why would you increase road traffic, pollution and transportation costs for any other reason than recycling and landfill? All activities that would be better undertaken elsewhere. 6) The application does not conserve or enhance the environment, it spoils this special woodland environment and impacts on our enjoyment of it. Please don't inflict this beautiful rural area with a landfill site in the foreseeable future.</p>
