Comments	<p>My parents live in Rudgwick and we frequently visit them and walk in the woods. The location is remote and tranquil, and this will be spoilt by the work being proposed. Light pollution will also be created in an area where there is currently none. The proposed operation would have a severe impact upon the enjoyment of the walking routes for all residents and visitors, impacting their wellbeing.</p> <p>Birdsong would be replaced by highly intrusive noise from HGV vehicles and excavators.</p> <p>In regards to demand for clay, there are three sites with 25 years supply of clay and one with 24 years, therefore the national and local level clay requirements are met. The applicant's argument for clay demand is further superseded by the closure of West Hoathly brickworks.</p> <p>In regards to the Waste site, there is currently sufficient capacity for Construction and Demolition waste in West Sussex, in established locations which are far more suitable. Furthermore, This is a greenfield; An National policy states that waste sites should be sited in built-up areas or brownfield sites</p>
